

Simple Dap Bag Pattern

Materials

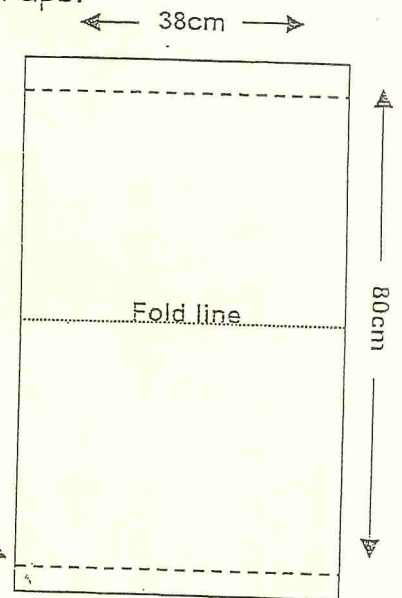
One piece of strong cotton or equivalent 80cm x 38cm, for the bag.

Two pieces of the same material 64cm x 6cm for the straps.

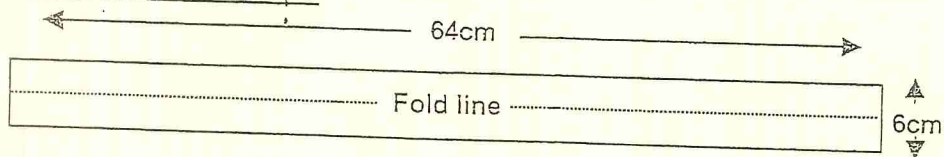
Sewing thread.

To make the bag

1. Using the larger piece of material, wrong sides together, make at 2cm turning at each end, and stitch.
2. Fold right sides together and stitch, with a 2cm seam allowance.
3. Neaten raw edges to prevent fraying (or zigzag stitch the seams.)
4. Turn bag right way out and press.



To make the handles/straps



1. Fold each long piece of material in half lengthways, wrong sides together and press.
2. On each long piece, sew along one short edge and the open long edge.
3. Turn right side out and press.
4. Attach both handles to the bag, on the outside as shown, making small turnings under, at the long ends, to neaten.
5. Clearly name the bag on the front, please.
