Simple Dap Bag Pattern

Materials

One piece of strong cotton or equivalent 80cm x 38cm, for the bag.

Two pieces of the same material 64cm x 6cm for the straps.


Sewing thread.

To make the bag

- 1. Using the larger piece of material, wrong sides together, make at 2cm turning at each end, and stitch.
- 2. Fold right sides together and stitch, with a 2cm seam allowance.
- 3. Neaten raw edges to prevent fraying (or zigzag stitch the seams.)
- 4. Turn bag right way out and press.

Fold line 2cm Seam Allowance

To make the handles/straps



- 1. Fold each long piece of material in half lengthways, wrong sides together and press.
- 2. On each long piece, sew along one short edge and the open long edge.
- 3. Turn right side out and press.
- 4. Attach both handles to the bag, on the outside as shown, making small turnings under, at the long ends, to neaten.
- 5. Clearly name the bag on the front, please.
