



## **Saltford School Parent Teacher Association**

### What is Saltford School PTA?

Welcome to Saltford School and Saltford School Parent Teacher Association (PTA), an important link between home and school. All Parents/carers and friends of the school are automatically members of the PTA.

### What does the PTA do?

The events organised by the PTA are many and varied. Each year we hold the very popular Christmas and Summer Fairs, which are the main fundraising events of the year. We also organise class cake sales, children's discos, film nights, Firework Night and adult events. As well as providing fun and social occasions, these events help to raise funds to provide extra items of equipment for the school. Many years ago the school swimming pool was built and equipped by the PTA. More recently, purchases for the school have ranged from new computers for each classroom, iPads, a new heater for the swimming pool, new playground equipment, online safety and other workshops, new digital smart boards for the classrooms a Defibrillator for the school and Forest School sessions.

### What are the benefits of being involved in the PTA?

It can help parents:

- improve the school and its facilities.
- get to know each other – whilst taking part in a range of fun activities.
- share common concerns.
- find out more about how the school works; and raise funds for extra items or services to enrich children's education

It can help children:

- receive a richer education as a result of items bought by the PTA; and
- benefit from your increased understanding of the school.

It can help teachers:

- reach potential volunteers and enthusiasts who may help with school projects.

The PTA is **not** a channel for concerns about particular children or for individual complaints.

### When is the next PTA meeting?

We usually meet in the school staff room next to the school library or virtually via a zoom link. The meetings are held once or twice each term and are open to all parents/carers. The meetings are very informal and short (about 1 to 1 ½ hours) and everyone is welcome!

The school newsletter, PTA Facebook Page and PTA section of the website will give details of dates and times of meetings as well as text messages. Copies of agendas and minutes of PTA meetings are emailed to all parents. The PTA also has a web page which gives details of current members, contacts and planned events. ### When is the PTA Annual General Meeting (AGM)?

The PTA AGM usually takes place in the autumn. We welcome all new / current parents and carers. Exact details will follow in the weekly School Newsletter. At the AGM we review PTA activities over the past year and look at plans for the future.

### Who can help?

Any parent or carer is welcome; we have Mums and Dads on the current PTA so don't be shy please come along and help. Your skills and contacts may be really helpful. Remember, many hands make light work. If you are only able to come to a few meetings a year it really does help!

### The PTA Committee

The PTA Committee comprises a group of elected parents/carers who are willing to organise events on behalf of the PTA. The Committee has a Chair (Head Teacher) and approximately 12 Committee Members including a Secretary and a Treasurer. We also need lots of other helpers, so please volunteer to assist with the major fundraising events of the year where we need lots of extra help including volunteering on stalls, selling of tickets etc. Requests for volunteers are normally made a few weeks before these events and even an hour of your time will much appreciated. We also request donations of items such as cakes and prizes for the tombola and raffles, details of which can be found in the school newsletter near the time of the events.

Most people are in the same boat, however, it doesn't matter – any help you can offer will be of value. There will always be something that you can do – even if you can't help on a regular basis.

How much money was raised by PTA in 2022/23?

The 2022/2023 school year was a fantastic year for fundraising. Thanks to the hard work and dedication of the committee, parents, staff, and everyone who attends or takes part in our PTA events, an amazing £28.5k was raised! This includes the following highlights:

How the money has been spent so far in 2022/23?

We are proud to have supported the whole school in taking part in Forest School sessions up at Manor Woods and an activity day with Super Pirates. We have purchased new football goals and bought books for the reading library. Key Stage 2 children have been given personal planners. We paid for the upgrade of a number of iPads, the building of a huge sandpit and funded new musical instruments. The PTA also organised a number of treats for the children including lollies at sports day, free trails, and competitions as well as a world book day author visit and badges for the children.

Also, whilst cake sales have been taking place for many years, historically money raised from these goes into the PTA ‘pot’ however, since 2015, any monies raised goes directly back to the classes involved allowing the children the opportunity to be involved in spending the money on equipment for their own class. Many opt to buy new Golden Time toys to enhance their reward time each week.
