

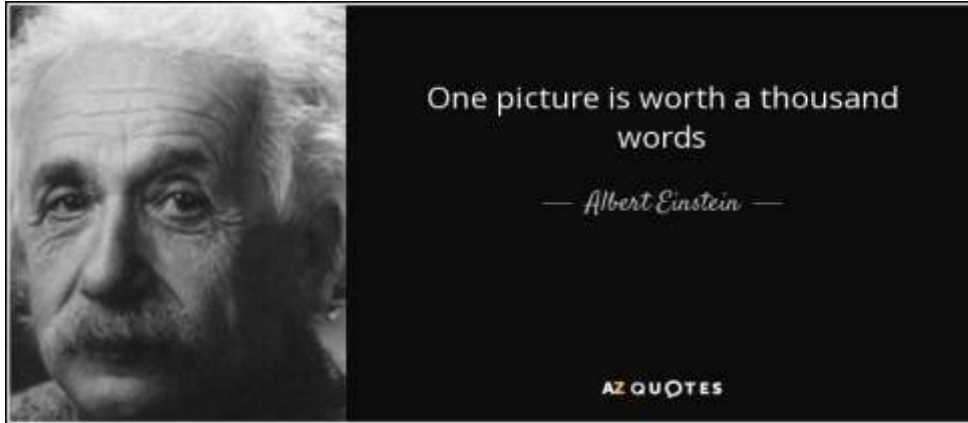
History Home Learning Corner.

Home learning task
