Forest school club will be open to Year 5 and 6 in Autumn Term 2.

What: Forest school is a wonderful opportunity for your child to experience nature and the outdoor environment in a fun, creative and hands on way. The children are encouraged to play, make, explore and further their interest and wonder for the natural world.

I will provide a snack such as flapjacks for the start of each session. Activities may also include toasting marshmallows, trying foraged food and cooking over the fire. Hot chocolate is a frequent offering for the colder months!
