## Year 1 Visit to Chepstow Castle - Monday 18th March 2024

Children need to be in school at normal time for a 9.00 am prompt departure. We will return in time for the end of school. Please could children wear school jumpers, jeans/trousers and comfortable shoes/trainers. Please ensure that they have a warm/waterproof coat, hat and gloves and bring a small backpack containing a drink and a snack. The cost of this trip will be £15.40 per child. The children will not require any extra money on the day. No child will be refused a place on the grounds that their parents do not wish to make a financial contribution, but unless a substantial number of parents wish their child to take part and are willing to make a financial contribution, the visit will have to be cancelled. Arrangements will be made for children whose parents do not wish them to take part. Payment for the trip can be made via MCAS under educational visits.
