We would like to invite you to an information evening regarding our Year 4 Health Education (sex and relationships education), the multiplication check and the Year 4 Camp meeting.

These meetings will take place on **Monday 26<sup>th</sup> February 2024**. The Health Education and times tables meeting will begin at 4.15 pm in Lime Class and the Camp meeting at 5.00 pm in the hall.

As you may be aware, we deliver our Personal, Social and Health Education (PSHE) learning using a scheme of work called Jigsaw. In term 6 all classes will have lessons delivered from a theme called 'Changing Me'. This unit teaches from the now **statutory** RSHE (Relationships, Sex and Health Education)curriculum as discussed in our recent parents' forum.

This is a valuable part of every child's education and all will benefit from a clear programme of RSHE. We will be using Jigsaw to deliver these lessons. This scheme brings together PSHE, emotional literacy, social skills and spiritual development in a weekly lesson programme.

The health education meeting will give an overview of the content and resources that we use to teach this essential subject. The times tables section will give you further details about the check itself and how we can all support the children to prepare for this.

The camp meeting will outline the activities for the week, as well as what families will need to prepare for the trip.
