- 2.1 The minutes were agreed as accurate.
- 3.0 Feedback and thank you for events so far
- 3.1 Mrs Sage provided an update regarding wind damage around the school during the recent storm. There was quite a lot of damage on site including to fencing, sheds, the EYFS and Year One covered area and the pool which suffered the most significant damage. The pool lost the gable end, roof panels and the pool cover, and liner were damaged badly. All of the details are with the loss adjuster and the school are providing quotes for repair, Mrs Sage will update further when info is available. There may be a possibility of grants being available. Mrs Sage thanked everyone for their support and messages.

The book swap went well again, but there are a lot of nursery age books which Ciara will look to donate to local nurseries. Charlotte Seavill offered to group donated books into age groups. Ciara and Charlotte to liaise on this.
